- 2. Successful Fundraising: Raised over \$1,000 through community support, enabling us to fund various restoration and improvement projects within the cemetery grounds.
- 3. Restoration Projects:
 - Erected a replica headstone in honor of a distinguished individual buried in Doby Cemetery.
 - Meticulously restored another significant headstone, ensuring its longevity and historical integrity.

4. Infrastructure Enhancements:

- Stabilized the Netto Pot fence, securing the cemetery's perimeter and preserving its boundaries.
- Installed a prominent sign, improving visibility and accessibility for visitors.

5. Cultural and Religious Installations:

• Erected a Blessed Mother statue, providing a place for spiritual reflection and reverence within the cemetery.

6. Collaborative Efforts:

 Partnered with the Hancock County NAACP for a collaborative effort to memorialize the enslaved individuals who worked on the Doby plantation. This ongoing initiative underscores our commitment to honoring all facets of Doby Cemetery's history.

7. Upcoming Blessing Ceremony:

 The priest will soon visit to bless the newly erected Mary statue, symbolizing our commitment to spiritual respect and unity within the cemetery.
